Frank was actively involved in the preparation of the IGCC (International Green Construction Code), First Draft.

The International Code Council (ICC), along with American Institute of Architects (AIA), ASTM International, the American Society of Heating, Refrigeration and Air Conditioning Engineers (ASHRAE), the U.S. Green Building Council (USGBC), and Illuminating Engineering Society (IES) introduced the world's first green construction code – the IGCC. The IGCC includes ANSI / ASHRAE / USGBC / IES Standard 189.1 as Jurisdictional Requirement Option. Application of the IGCC components will ensure integration with other International Code provisions and provide criteria that have been reviewed by experts in sustainable building science, safety, and building performance.
