The UNF Student Union (LEED registered) and the UNF College of Education and Human Services (LEED Gold) sit side by side on the UNF Campus. This case study presentation of these two buildings will compare and contrast their LEED goals, sustainability strategies, LEED process and implementation, as well as highlight missed opportunities and lessons learned.



Mark Gelfo has become a local champion of the U.S. Green Building Council's (USGBC) LEED process. He was one of the founding members of the USGBC North Florida Chapter and served two terms as chapter president.

He currently serves as Education Chair for the chapter and provides leadership in frequent LEED study workshops for professionals seeking accreditation. He received a Bachelor of Science in Architectural Engineering from Penn State University. In 2007, he became a member of TLC's Board of Directors. He is a Professional Engineer in the discipline of Electrical Engineering, a LEED Accredited Professional BD+C and O+M, and an ACG Certified Commissioning Authority. He is currently serving as Secretary of the American Commissioning Group.

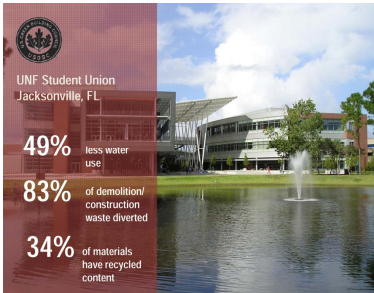
