Please join us for our Annual Chapter Update as we introduce the 2010-2011 Board of Directors and give an overview of our Chapter goals for the coming year.



Our keynote speaker, Vince Siebold, will discuss Low Impact Development (LID) and some best practices, the City's plans to identify and incorporate LID design criteria into a Duval County LID manual, and how LID

relates to vertical green building and development.

Vince received a B.S. in Environmental Engineering from the University of Florida in 1989 and a Masters of Business Administration from the University of North Florida in 2000. He began his career at the Department of Environmental Regulation (now called the Department of Environmental Protection) Northeast District Office, Jacksonville, in 1989. He transferred to DEP Headquarters, Tallahassee, in 1998 and returned to Jacksonville in 2005. His work experience with DEP encompassed permitting, compliance, monitoring, and rulemaking for all aspects of the Water Facilities Program.

In March 2007 Vince accepted the position as Chief of the Environmental Quality Division (EQD) for the City of Jacksonville. EQD is the local environmental regulatory agency for Duval County and has been in existence since 1968. With over 110 employees the EQD administers and monitors the City of Jacksonville's air and water resource management activities, with particular emphasis on pollution control issues. It also enforces laws related to environmental quality issues. Responsibilities include air, odors, noise, surface water, groundwater, underground storage tanks, hazardous wastes, and wetlands.
